

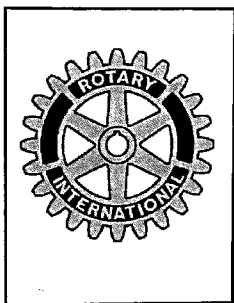

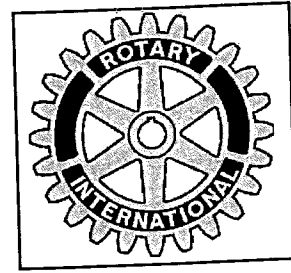

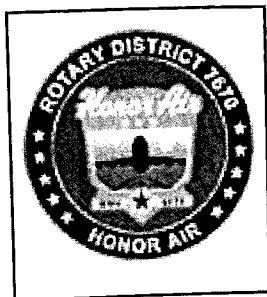

Tay Bronaugh, Treasurer of Troop 207, receives a check for \$700 from Bingo Chairman Jodie Cook.

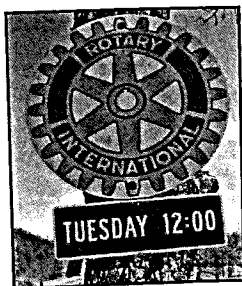
Upcoming Programs
