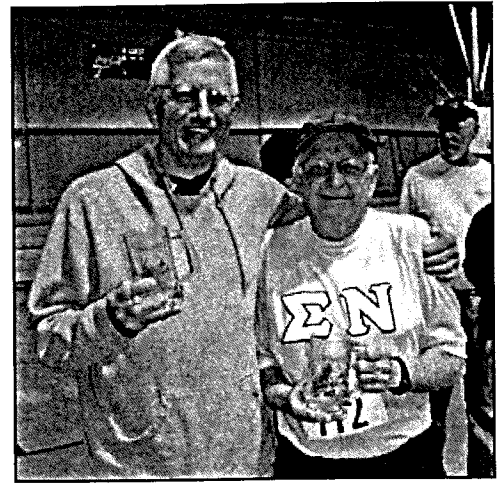

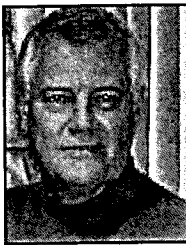


**District 7670 Assembly – May 16th:**
