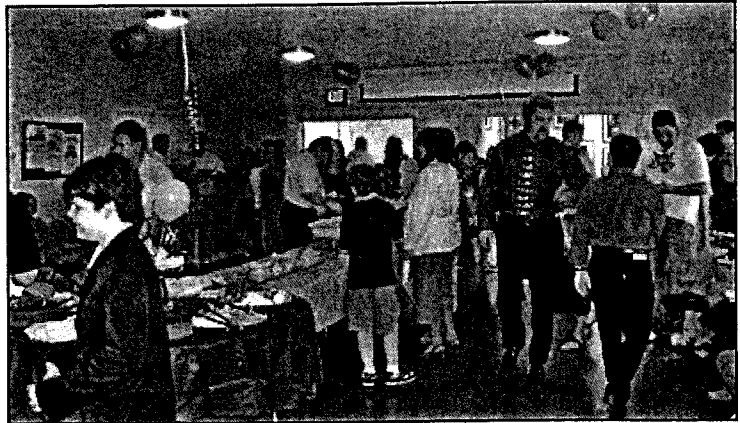


Barefoot in the Park – June 2nd:

Loaves & Fishes Bingo – June 4th:

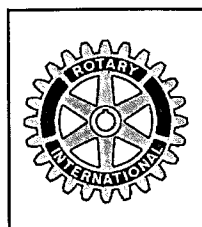
