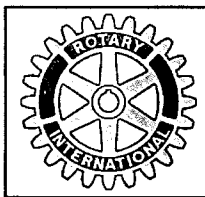
District 7670, which includes Highlands, has re-done its Web site. One feature you may find interesting is the District Newsletter which is readily available. Visit www.rotary7670.org.
