# Cub Scout Bingo - This Thursday Night

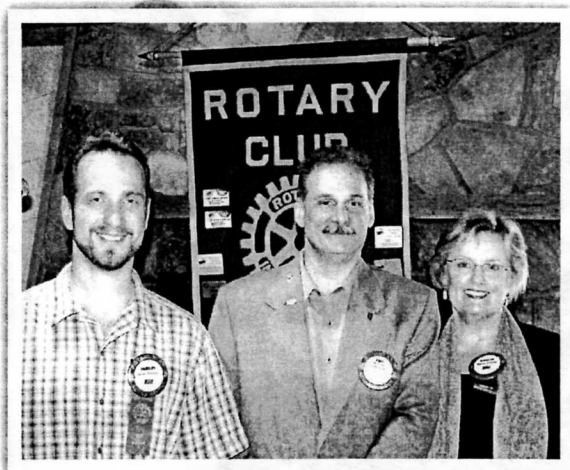

## Children's Dental Health Project

Our Rotary Club, in conjunction with Mountain Top Rotary, is in the organizational stages of funding and sponsoring a three part dental program for the Highlands School. The plan consists of three distinct programs:

- The first program is a weekly fluoride mouth rinse program conducted by the staff of the school for grades K through 5. Volunteers are needed.
- The second is a once a year Dental screening – a visual dental examination/screening conducted by a local dentist and Rotary volunteer at the school. The results of this screening will be sent to the student's parents.
- And third, a Dental Education day where students will be provided information and demonstrations of proper oral hygiene. Dental products and handouts will be provided. This program will also be conducted by a dentist and Rotary volunteers,
