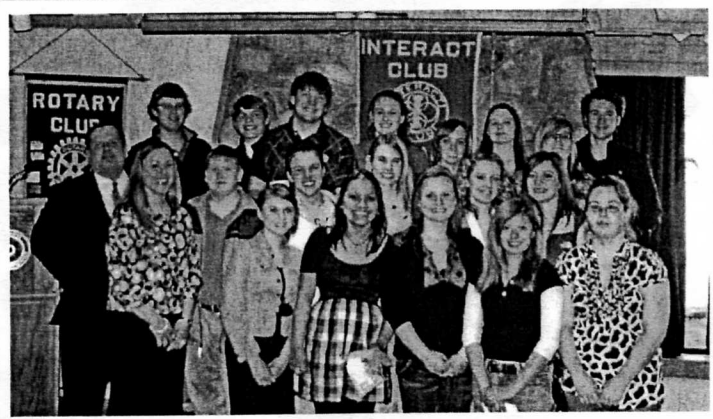
## Literacy Bingo fun
