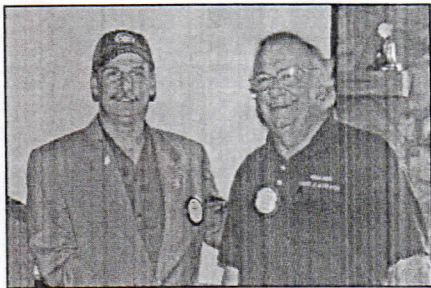

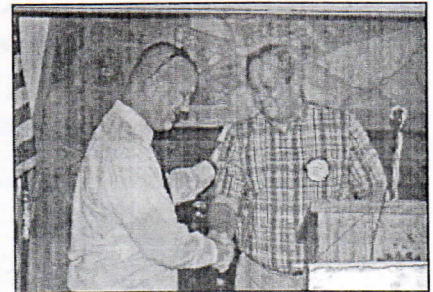
President Schmitt presented a check to Robert E. Smith for the Hudson Library.
