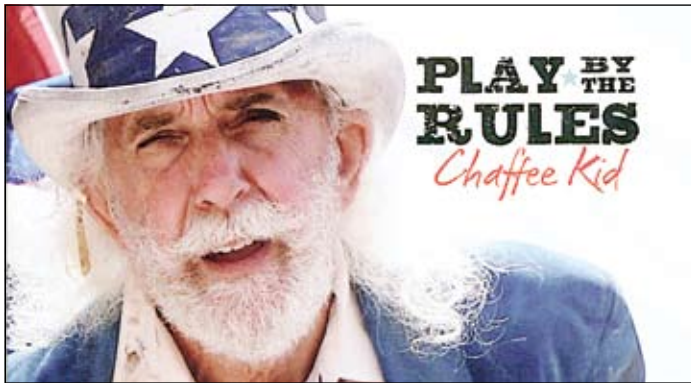

John Chaffee – "Uncle Sam" (Chaffee Kid)



After a career in broadcasting, with Malrite Communications Group in Cleveland (copywriting, programming, management in both radio and television) John began pursuing a lifelong dream, songwriting. In 2004, he released a song he wrote, "Someone is Missing at Christmas", performed by Anne Cochran, which in the following year, reached the #11 position on Billboard's Adult Contemporary chart. The song continues to be played each season on stations across the country, and a portion of the proceeds are directed to breast cancer and ovarian cancer organizations. Last year, following the appointment to the position of Treasury Secretary of a man who didn't pay his taxes, John began work on "Play By The Rules". The audio track was recorded in Nashville at Trax Studios, and in the summer, at Cleveland, Ohio locations, the video was shot and produced at Commercial Recording Studios. The song has been featured in Country Weekly and UpCountry (UK) magazines, and in November won the 2009 Hollywood Music in Media Award for best country song. John, as Uncle Sam (Chaffee Kid) made his first speaking appearance in Florida in March, addressing the "state of the nation". He's a Glenville/Cleveland resident.
