The speakers at last week's meeting were Hilary Wilkes and Derek Taylor that gave a brief history of AHEC (Advancing Highlands Education Committee) and an update of its current activities. AHEC is a group of community members whose goal is to raise private funds for the betterment of Highlands School. Working with administration and teachers, the committee identified specific infrastructure and teacher needs at the school. It has helped to secure ipads for all elementary school students, laptops for middle and high schoolers, active boards for the classrooms and a set of Google Expedition reality goggles to be used across all grades. There are also plans to upgrade the library and build a Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) closet..

Total people over 65 vaccinated - 2,138
Number of vaccine clinics - 10
