# **Memorial Day**

Next Monday, May 31, is Memorial Day. Memorial Day is a federal holiday in the United States for honoring and mourning the military personnel who have died in the performance of their military duties while serving in the United States Armed Forces.

American Legion Post 370 will conduct a ceremony on that day, at 10:00 a.m., at Veteran's Plaza, 372 Oak Street in front of the police station. Ed McCloskey, Commander of Post 370 and Marine Corps Veteran, will lead the ceremony, which includes the installation of additional "Honor Walk Bricks" in the Veteran's Honor Walkway honoring Veterans from Highlands, Cashiers, Scaly Mountain and surrounding area.

On Thursday, May 27, at 5:30 p.m., volunteers will gather at Memorial Park to place flags on the graves of veterans. For years, Phil Potts has organized this event, as well as a similar event on Veterans' Day, and the placement of wreaths as part of "Wreaths across America", in December.
