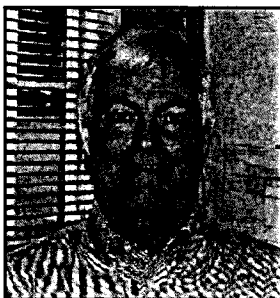
After winning SuperBingo...
