

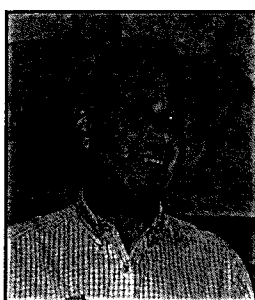

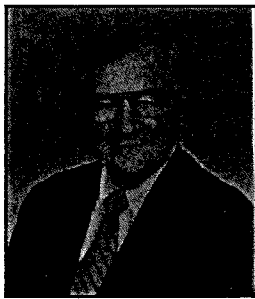

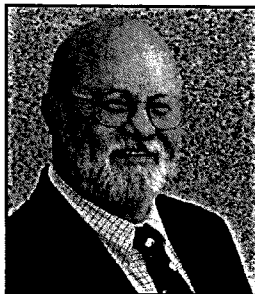
Upcoming Programs
